

Dear Parents,

We are excited to be opening childcare up during the second worship service! This will begin on Sunday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. We want to give you some information so you will know what to expect if you choose to drop your child off on Sunday. Please know that if you are not comfortable leaving your child yet, we completely understand and want you to do what you feel is best! Your child is always welcome to stay in the worship service with you, and you can request a Praise Pack for them to use during service. While we can't wait for your child to come for childcare, we ask that if they have any cold-like symptoms (runny nose, cough, sneezing, sore throat, etc.), please do not bring them to the childcare area.

Check In:

- Behind the CAC check in counter, there will be an **enclosed play area walled off by dividers**.
- Temperature will be taken at drop off. If your child has a **temperature of 100.4 or above** (CDC guidelines), he or she will not be permitted in the play area.
- A nursery volunteer will be ready to check your child in for you.
- Children will be **given a squirt of hand sanitizer** by an adult when they enter the play area. If you are not comfortable with us using hand sanitizer, please let us know and a volunteer will take your child to wash his/her hands.
- We ask that you **please do not come into the play area** when dropping your child off.

Play Time:

- We will **not be trying to social distance** any of the kids. If you are not comfortable leaving your child because of this, we understand.
- There will be toys for the kids to play with and they will be removed and sterilized if a child puts a toy in his/her mouth.
- **Diaper bags** will remain outside the play area
- We will have **hand sanitizer for the adults and for the kids as needed**. If you are not comfortable with us using hand sanitizer, please let us know and a volunteer will take your child to wash his/her hands.

Snacks:

- **No cups, snacks or toys from home** will be allowed into the play area. We have cups which can be labeled if a child needs a cup. A volunteer will stay with your child until they are finished drinking and then put the cup out of reach.
- **We will not be having snacks during their time with us**. If this changes, we will provide individually wrapped snacks.

Pick Up:

- Pickup will be as normal. We ask that you **do not come into the play area** but wait at the check-out counter and we will bring your child to you.

**Masks** will not be required for volunteers or children. If you feel uncomfortable with any of the things listed above, we encourage you to keep your child with you at this time. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact Willa or Laura. We welcome any questions you may have. We've missed having your kids during the worship time and look forward to seeing them!
